I. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:35 pm, Anne Wager-Rounds, Chairperson of the Facilities Committee, made a presentation of the Capital Plan to the Carroll Hill School PTO members.

VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT (oral)

The Superintendent addressed issues regarding safety and academics at the secondary schools, specifically focusing on Doyle Middle School, and the need for us to develop and implement protocals and procedures for improving the school.

Dr. Casey Parker, Principal of Carroll Hill School, presented a DVD introducing faculty members and illustrating the programs provided by CHS. CHS was recently recommended to apply for national Blue Ribbon School honor. CHS is 1 of 19 schools among thousands in the country who has been chosen to apply.
