V. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

- •Mr. Atiba-Weza congratulated Troy High School's football team for their regional title victory and NYS finalist game at The Dome in Syracuse.
- •Low-performing schools were labeled such because some students within a building did not perform at level. The Commissioner will meet with those schools and state will provide resources to get us back on target.
- •Effective Use of Elementary School (EUES) Committee has been formed and a school will be closed due to low enrollment. The committee will arrive at the best way to do this. The Board will make the decision.

- 1. Finance Committee Mr. Schofield reported on the November 8th meeting. A citizens advisory committee has been formed to assist with budget process. There was nothing unusual in the monthly reports. Budget development discussions included general support.
