#### V. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Staff Development Day was held on September 1st for TCSD faculty. The Alternative Learning Program is in place at School 1 under direction of Mr. Canfield. Mr. Atiba-Weza stated he hopes for some financial support from Race to the Top but nothing is certain at this time. District budget is good and we will not need to go into reserve. He reported that charter school numbers have increased.
