IX. CAPITAL PROJECT PRESENTATION - MOSAIC ARCHITECTS

John Montagne of The Chazen Companies gave a powerpoint presentation of the schematic design of THS athletic fields. Proposed plans include new gateway, additional parking, reconstruction of football, baseball, softball fields and track plus additional tennis courts and multipurpose field. Advantages of synthetic turf were discussed. Current drainage problems will be addressed. Lighting upgrades will be more energy-efficient and allow for expanded playing schedule. Construction to begin summer 2011.
