I. MEETING CALLED TO ORDER

At 6:00 pm Mrs. Wager-Rounds called the meeting to order.

III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:00 pm Mrs. Wager-Rounds made a motion to move to executive session for the purpose of discussing pending litigation and settlement of employee claim.

Executive Session was followed by Finance Committee meeting at 6:30 to 7:15 pm.

IV. PUBLIC SESSION

At 7:15 pm Mrs. Wager-Rounds opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

V. DISTRICT ANNOUNCEMENTS

Mrs. Wager-Rounds read the following announcements:

School 1 students from "Community Art Program" handmade scarves for School 2 kindergartners; School 18 adopted 8 families for holiday giving; Capital Communications donated \$250 visa card for School 18 classroom supplies; RPI fraternity delivered holiday gifts for every School 2 student; and School 2 hosted community dinner to kick off "Cleaner and Greener" project.

VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr. Brian Howard, Interim Superintendent, reported that Principal Linda Martin will be forming a School 2 playground committee. \$14 million is spent for special education and will be studied by an independent organization who will present recommendations. He is researching different outside agencies. Board members agreed Dr. Howard should move forward on this.

VII. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT - L. MARTIN

Principal Linda Martin made powerpoint presentation with the following information: 423 students/34 students in PK; PS2 enrollment increased by 45 students since last year; 97% students receive free or reduced lunch; 251 students walk to school; 80 students attend Sunnyside Center for aftercare and 10-15 students at any given time are homeless.

School 2 has been designated by SED as "in need of improvement" and is in first phase known as "improvement phase". 2011-12 focus is new reading program, mathematics instruction and implementation of "school connection" model. Miss Martin stated it is her expectation that all students will graduate from high school.
