III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

At 6:30 pm Mr. Schofield made a motion to move to Executive Session for the purpose of discussing a contractual matter and pending litigation. This was seconded by Mr. Strang and carried 9-0. Invited to attend were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Ms. O'Neill, Mrs. Miaski and Ms. Ahearn.

IV. PUBLIC SESSION

At 7:10 pm Mr. Schofield called the meeting to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

V. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Mr. Carmello, Mr. Strang and Ms. Denio met with four legislators on Lobby Day; they delivered over 1700 advocacy letters signed by parents and taxpayers. Mr. Strang provided graphs to better understand our budget challenges. Mr. Carmello is hopeful for positive results in aid. Draft 3 of the budget will be presented at March 19th workshop meeting and he would like to add a workshop on March 26th. The budget will be adopted on April 2nd.

VI. PUBLIC INPUT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

- (1) Dominick Rizzo (CSEA President) CSEA is sending out a press release opposing the tax cap which handcuffs local school districts. He would like the Board's support and have their names appear on press release.
- (2) Tracy Griswold (TMS Parent) She has had continuous problems with transportation since September. Her daughter joined the swim team and the bus stop was removed after 8 years because she temporarily was not on the bus. Ms. Griswold was told on by Transportation Department that this would be resolved but has not been corrected yet. She was told there is a 5-day rule for removing bus stops but this has never been communicated before.

Mrs. Wager-Rounds said this is the first she has heard of a 5-day rule regarding bus stops. She said it would make sense to call the parent if a child is not on bus for 5 days. Mr. Carmello said there is no 5-day rule and there must have been a miscommunication; he will look into this. Mr. Carmello said Sean Broderick and other Durham reps are present tonight and they will help us improve service and address problems. Mr. Carmello will follow up on Mrs. Griswold's issue with the bus stop.

(3) Ebi Campbell (Teaching Assistant in ALP) - As part of Black History Month she was given permission to create a unique program for students and decided to put a twist on Black History. She and other staff at ALP talked with students about their personal experiences. Ms. Campbell made a presentation about her Nigerian heritage and told students to take pride in their differences. She thanked her colleagues for their support and Mrs. Bruno for taking time to see this PR opportunity which resulted in story in *The Record*.
