III. TECHNOLOGY AND SECURITY CAPITAL PROJECT UPDATE - J. HEINER

Mr. Jared Heiner, Director of Technology, made a presentation regarding the Capital Project for Technology and Security (approved by voters on December 10, 2013).

Mr. Heiner reported that the Capital Project Committee meets regularly. The committee has three main objectives: network, security and technology upgrades. <u>Security</u> - An architectural and engineering "walk through" has taken place. There has been a cultural change with swipe cards, A phone cameras and digital security software upgrades for unified, district-wide coverage. Equipment will be installed across the District at access points. There have been 2-way radio upgrades so we are joining Troy Police Department's digital truncated system, which was done at the request of the Police Department. The 2-way radio system is cost-efficient which utilizes the investment of the future to leverage wireless push-to-talk end points. Additionally radio features: link to district cellphones; 2-way radio functionality; 1-1 intercom feature; 1P phone functionality and public address connectivity. We also have early warning systems with panic buttons and strobes. Troy Police Department is now connected into Troy MIddle School and School 2.

<u>Network Update</u> - We are excited about upgrades in the classrooms. Architectural and engineering walked through of all spaces was done. They had great ideas for retro-fit of smart boards. Mr. Heiner presented on a smartboard supported by an attached stand which relieves asbestos and electric issues. Units are touchscreen with no overhead lights; teachers will not have to give up wall space. Each device will have a document camera with amazing magnification. Mr. Heiner gave a demonstration of wireless applications. The district will have robust wireless coverage throughout buildings.

<u>Technology</u> - Every classroom will have a document camera, Smart monitor, Smart Notebook software and Airplay functionality. This leads to endless possibilities with laptop integration, tablet phone compatibility, mobility, paradigm shift, 10 "touch" feature and video conferencing.

<u>Project Timeline</u> - We have submitted plans to SED and doing final review and budget assessment. Once approved, we begin the Bid process and procurement. We will work with Project Manager to create a schedule. Work will begin in the High School.

<u>Discussion</u> - Mrs. Harvin asked about securing Smartboard equipment to the floor with bolts and would it leave a mark if moved. Mr. Heiner said any holes could be easily filled. There is less disruption to secure unit to the floor than to secure it to the wall. Mrs. Harvin said the upgrades are excellent for security and very worthwhile.

<u>Martha Walsh (former BOE member)</u> - Ms. Walsh stated she did not make a statement at the time of her resignation at the March 31, 2014 meeting. She would like to say that it has been an honor to serve as Board member for Troy. We have been very good stewards of the taxpayers' money and our accomplishments include a new Middle School, School 2 grant, relocation of District Offices and a very capable person at the helm. We had disagreements behind closed doors, but the children always come first.

<u>Brian Dunn</u> (Principal of Troy Middle School) - Mr. Dunn would like to welcome and congratulate teachers receiving tenure appointments tonight.

<u>Carol Harvin</u> - Mrs. Harvin would like to thank the residents who voted for her and those who supported the budget. Mr. Carmello is doing an excellent job and she is looking forward to working with her colleagues in the District.

<u>Niomi Manegault</u> (parent and founder of D.A.R.T.) - Ms. Manegault said there are many negative outlets surrounding our teens today, such as drugs, and the schools have a heavy load. She has formed an organization to give students a positive future called D.A.R.T. (Dreams Are Real Things). Many parents don't know how to get their children into college; they will offer free tutoring. She would like to communicate with teachers. Ms. Manegault is introducing her ideas to Rensselaer County and the Mayor.
