III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mr. Schofield made a motion to move to Executive Session regarding a pending litigation. Invited in were Mr. Carmello, Dr. Watson, Ms. O'Neill and Ms. Ahearn.

IV. PUBLIC HEARING ON CODE OF CONDUCT

At 6:10 pm Mr. Schofield called the public session to order with the Pledge of Allegiance.

At this time the Public Hearing began with a presentation by Dr. Donna Watson, Assistant Superintendent for Curriculum & Instruction. Dr. Watson explained that there is a Code of Conduct Committee with representation from the entire district. The committee has been met throughout the year to review and revise the Code accordingly.

A new District-wide belief was stated: "This code is founded upon a firm belief that the best conduct always begins with strong, positive relationships between students, families and all people who work for the Troy City School District."

The 2014-15 Code has been revised on the elementary school level with wording to read more positively. Consequences to infractions are listed in ranges as opposed to ultimatums. Principals will now have more leeway with assigning consequences. Middle School changes include the addition of terminology for "active/aggressive bystander" defined as anyone who promotes, encourages or supports misbehavior that is harmful to others. This individual will be held responsible for his/her actions. High School changes include the revision of the word "will" to "may" so that students do not automatically proceed to a Superintendent's hearing on a second offense.

Also changes as a result of TAC-D language has been revised to be less reactionary and more preventive and responsive. Dr. Watson believes that these updates to the Code of Conduct will help make our district-wide belief a reality. A booklet version of the Code of Conduct has been created for easy reference and the complete document will be posted to the website.

<u>Discussion -</u> Mrs. Harvin said she likes TAC-D and glad we no longer use OSS for consequences. Dr. Watson said she will talking with new teachers about their strategies for re-directing students. Mrs. Wager-Rounds stated a lot of our forms are not parent-friendly. The booklet of the code will be helpful. Dr. Watson said it will be handed out at Open House and translated in Spanish.
