### III. EXECUTIVE SESSION

Mrs. Wager-Rounds made a motion to enter into Executive Session at 6:00 pm for purpose of pending litigation and discussion of Superintendent's determination. Mr. Carmello, Ms. O'Neill, Ms. Culligan and Mrs. O'Grady-Parent also attended.

### IV. PUBLIC SESSION

At 7:00 pm the Board re-convened to public session and opened the meeting with the Pledge of Allegiance.

#### V. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT

Dr, Howard reported that there were serious problems with transportation for the return of classes. He apologized to the public for poor service and stated it was inexcusable. He has met with the bus company and will take corrective action.

Dr. Howard stated there were false statements recently circulated regarding Carroll Hill School's class size of 35 students; this is not true. A statement was made regarding use of an academic trailer; this is not true. There will be some adjustments needed in the elementary school as result of the re-districting.

## VI. PRINCIPAL'S REPORT/ SCHOOL 1 (ALTERNATIVE LEARNING PROGRAM)

Mr. Canfield, Administrator, made a presentation and spoke on the importance of ALP program which provides educational services to many students in need. Key component of this program is motivating students who are discouraged and do not care. There is new student handbook for weekly goals and a monthly newsletter. ALP goals are to improve student attendance; decrease behavior referrals and improve academics. School 1 difference is use of base-line data; smaller class sizes, attendance accountability; strong focus on core academic classes.

#### VII. PUBLIC INPUT ON AGENDA AND NON-AGENDA ITEMS

- (1) Elijah McGill (former THS student) It is important to get students more involved in school. We need to change the way teachers work with students and turn students' minds "on". This was not done when he attended Troy schools.
- (2) Derrick Conyers (former THS student) Believes education system is failing our children; students are not prepared for real world. Recommended oral classroom instruction and discussion for long-term retention.
- (3) Mark Walsh (TTA President) Thanked former students for speaking and being honest. Thanked BOE for re-opening ALP program at School 1. Thank you for addressing concerns with transportation and class sizes. Congratulations to Katie Neville for recall to f/t position.
