VI. SUPERINTENDENT'S REPORT - J. CARMELLO

Mr. Carmello introduced Erin Clary, full-time Communications Specialist for the District.

VII. TMS PRINCIPAL PRESENTION - B. DUNN

Mr. Brian Dunn, principal of Troy Middle School, gave a summary of the middle school's progress as an identified FOCUS school. He believes TMS is well-positioned to provide all students a challenging and enlightening middle school experience.

TMS met District Goal 2 with a 6% reduction in behavioral incidents. Both accelerated algebra and geometry classes posted 92% and 100% passing grades, respectively. Eighth Grade science improved by 5%. Overall math results were positive in Grades 6-8. Eighth Grade ELA proficiency was 21%. We are beginning to close the achievement gap with our students.

TMS staff is learning and implementing the "efficacy" package. TMS has redesigned their student leadership model by merging NJHS and Student Government with common service projects. There is an unprecedented number of new staff this year: 34 new teachers, teaching assistants and monitors bringing a lot of new energy.
